

RULES - HORSE SECTION

- 1. The Society reserves the right to refuse an entry and to vary the order of the schedule.
- 2. The Society reserves the right to substitute other Judges for those named or to make additional appointments.

 The decision of the Judge is always to be accepted as final.
- 3. The Society reserves the right to alter times, split, amalgamate or cancel classes if found to be necessary and withhold prize money if entries are low or at the Judge's discretion.
- 4. Rosettes will be provided in all classes to sixth place.
- 5. Objections must be made to the Horse Secretary within ten minutes of the end of the Class, in writing and accompanied by a deposit of £100, returnable if the objection is sustained.
- 6. No claim can be entertained for anything that may happen to Competitors, Spectators, their property, servants or horses in connection with this Show. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the Society against any legal action or expenses arising from any incident in connection with this Show.
- 7. When not competing, horses must be kept strictly to the Horsebox Park, collecting rings, practice area and horse walks. Horses tied to horseboxes or trailers must not be left unattended.
- 8. All dogs must be kept on a lead and under strict control.
- 9. All horses in ridden classes must be four years old and over.
- 10. All horses entered in British Showjumping classes must be owned by members of British Showjumping, registered with British Showjumping and ridden by members, in accordance with Rule 79, and will be subject to British Showjumping rules.
- 11. British Showjumping Rule 79 withdrawals: notice must be given to the Secretary not later than **48 hours** before the Show day and must be confirmed in writing in order to be eligible for a 50% refund.
- 12. British Showjumping Rule 31.5 Unaccompanied Competitors must provide the Show Organiser a contact telephone number in case of an emergency.
- 13. Declarations for jumping classes must be made to the Collecting Ring half an hour before the start of the class.
- 14. YOUR COOPERATION IS REQUESTED TO GIVE YOUR NUMBERS TO THE COLLECTING RING EARLY, INDICATING THAT YOU ARE PREPARED TO START. THE SHOW MUST RUN TO TIME AND IS RELUCTANT TO IMPLEMENT THE RULE WHEREBY, IN THE EVENT OF THE JUDGES NOT BEING SATISFIED WITH THE RATE OF PROGRESS, THEY ARE EMPOWERED TO CLOSE THE COMPETITION.
- 15. No free cars are allowed into the Horsebox Park unless towing a horse trailer. If a car pass is required for entry to the Horsebox Park, application must be made in advance on the entry form; cost per pass is £5.00. N.B. Public car parks are FREE.
- 16. All mounted riders on the Showground must wear hats conforming to the relevant British Standard for the activity; these must be correctly fitted and chinstraps secured. It is also strongly recommended that competitors wear these hats at all times when handling exhibits.
- 17. Local classes are open to horses stabled within 15 miles of the Showground. Exhibitors entering local classes or eligible for 'Best Local' rosettes must wear a white armband (to be provided by themselves).
- 18. In the unfortunate event of an animal dying or being destroyed on the Showground, the Owner/Exhibitor is responsible for the cost of disposal and agrees to indemnify the Society in respect of that cost.
- 19. Postal entries close 21st July 2012. Any entries received after this date and entries made on the day will be accepted providing the class is not over-subscribed and that 50% is added to the published entry fee. Entry fees on the day must be paid in cash. Please note that entry fees include VAT.
- 20. 50% refunds will only be made on production of a veterinary or medical certificate within 7 days of the show date. £2 per horse per class will be deducted for administrative expenses.
- 21. In the event of cancellation or postponement of the show, entry fees will be returned **on receipt of an SAE** within ten days of cancellation or postponement less £2.00 per competitor to cover administrative costs.
- 22. All competitors entering affiliated classes must abide by the appropriate breed Society rules.
- 23. There is a charge of £3.00 per competitor for the provision of first aid facilities.
- 24. HEALTH & SAFETY: The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present in accordance with Health and Safety Legislation. For these measurers to be effective everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instruction of the Organisers, Officers and Stewards.
- 25. All competitors/exhibitors must have adequate and appropriate Third Party Liability Insurance cover.
- 26. TROPHIES No trophy may be taken from the showground before competitors have entered their details in the Trophy Book and a deposit of £10 per trophy has been made. Deposits will be refunded in full when trophies are returned clean, undamaged and in time for the next year's show.


